ERC provides **attractive, long-term funding** to support investigators and their research teams to pursue **groundbreaking, high-gain and high-risk** research. ERC frontier research grants are awarded on the basis of **scientific excellence**. Applications can be made in **any field of research**. Independent researchers **of any age and career stage** from **anywhere in the world** can apply. The funding supports investigators looking to **set up or consolidate** their own independent research team or programme, as well as to already **established research leaders**. Evaluation of ERC grant applications is conducted by **peer review panels** composed of renowned scientists and scholars selected by the ERC Scientific Council. The panels may be assisted by independent external experts working remotely.
